<u>The Golden Buddha Temple</u>, which well known in the name of "Wat Trimith" this temple located one of the most beautiful Golden Buddha which was made from very high percent of gold in meditation Buddha. This temple was built around 1832. It was formerly named Wat Sam Chin (Three Chinese Temple), after three Chinese donors who contributed their properties tobuild the temple in 1939. It's name was changed to Wat Traimit Wittayaram and became a royal temple in 1956. The Buddha image named Sukhothai Traimit located inside the Wiharn (Hall of

and became a royal temple in 1956. The Buddha image named Sukhothai Traimit located inside the Wiharn (Hall of Worship) belongs to Sukhothai period, presumably made during the reign of King Ramkhamhaeng the Great (1277-1317). The image was moved from Wat Mahathat in Sukhothai to Wat Chotinaram (Wat Phrayakrai) during the reign of King Rama III. Then it was shifted to this temple and stored in the pavilion before moving to the present location in 1955. Reverend Phra Visutha-thibordee, the late abbot whose image is in the sitting position in front of this temple, joined in the construction of the temple building for the Golden Buddha Image to be enshrined. When the building was completed and while preparations were being made to move this Golden Buddha Image to the building, the lime covering of the image was cracked revealing the guilt golden buddha image inside. The entire covering was then removed. Only then did the people realize that it was a Golden Buddha Image. Part of the covering plaster is also on display inside the temple building. Originally, this Golden Buddha Image was completely covered with plaster to conceal it from the enemy then invading Thailand and was installed as the principal Buddha image in the main temple building of Choti-naram Temple or Wat Phrayakrai, Yannawa District, Bangkok in the third reign of the Chakkri Dynasty in hte Ratansakosin era.

<u>The Marble Temple</u>, or Wat Benchamabophit is one of the most beautiful temples of Thailand. Built by the order of King Rama V in 1899, its ordination hall was built of white Carara Italian marble. The engineer and architect were Italians namely Carlo Allegri and Mario Tamagno in that order. Standing in front of the ordination hall, you will enjoy an impressive view of the light-coloured marble building with a graceful multi-tiered roof covered with yellow glazed tiles, and a pair of white marble lions standing guard at its front door. Enshrined in the ordination hall is the presiding Buddha image Phra Phuttha Chinnarat. It is a bronze replica of the original statue of the Sukhothai Period (1238-1438) which is still enshrined in Wat Phrasi Rattana Mahathat in Phitsanulok Province in the north of Thailand.

<u>The Grand Palace</u> The construction of The Grand Palace began in 1782 during the reign of King Rama I, THE FOUNDER OF Chakri Dynasty, to become a royal residence, and it has the utmost architectural symbol of Thailand ever since. The Grand Palace served as a significant royal resident until 1925 and is now used for ceremonial purposes only. You can visit The Royal Pantheon, Chakri Maha Prasat, Borom Phiman Hall, and The Audience Hall of Amarindra Vinitchai, Coronation Hall.

The Grand palace is divided into three main zones: The Outer Court, Home to royal offices, public buildings and the Temple of Emerald Buddha. The Middle Court, which is where the most important residential and state buildings are. The Inner Court which is exclusively reserved for the king, his queen and his consorts.

The Emerald Buddha Temple or "Wat Phra Sri Rattana Satsadaram Temple" is renowned as the most beautiful and important Buddhist temple in Thailand. It houses Pra Kaeo Morakot (The Emerald Buddha), the most highly revered Buddha Image carved fro a single block of Fine Jade ,which you can see a parton, Murral Paintings, The Statues of Demon-Guardians, The Golden Stupa and show. It is not know for sure when the Emerald Buddha was carved however judging from the appearance and style one could conclude it was carved in Northern Thailand not much earlier than the fifteenth century. On the other hand, the Emerald Buddha, which is in an attitude of meditation, looks much like some of the Buddha images of Southern India and Sri Lanka. This attitude of meditation has never been popular in other Thai carvings of Buddha images so one might assign the origin to one of the aforementioned countries

The Temple of the Emerald Buddha is the most sacred structure in the Kingdom and the repository of the spirit for all the Thai people. The history of the Emerald Buddha itself dates back more than 600 years and also represents the struggle of the Thai people to maintain their independence from foreign aggressors.

When King Rama I established Bangkok, or Rattanakosin, as his capital in 1782 he added the Temple of the Emerald Buddha in the eastern section of the Royal Grand Palace in order to install the Emerald Buddha. During its two hundred year history the Chapel had undergone several renovations, restorations, and additions. The Royal Chapel thus incorporates no less than two centuries of Rattanakosin craftsmanship which is an expression of the essential entity of the Thai people.

The best time to visit is from 07:00 a.m. 11:00 a.m. The vendors, wearing traditional farmer dresses and hats, are mostly local peasants that bring in their things to sell on their rowing boats. On and along the canal, you can find delicious Thai food, wide variety of tropical fruits and vegetable and many colorful home-made products - A very pleasant scene to see and remember! You should not miss the opportunity to experience by yourself sitting and eating on one of these rowing boats on the canal. (More details)

You will have experience on long-tailed boat ride for about 30 minutes, passing through remote plantations and Thai villages along the river and winding canal. At the floating market of Damnernsaduak, it is amazing to see a lively market scene of local vendors selling local foods, tropical fruits, and numerous handicraft products on their boats.

Carry on with the visit to Royal Thai Handicraft Center where you can see Thai artisans work on precious teak woods into impressive wood carvings

The Damnernsaduak Floating Market is located at Damnern Saduak District, Ratchaburi Province, about 105 kms (65 miles) from Bangkok. According to history around 1866 King Rama IV ordered that a 32 kms long canal be dug at Damnernsaduak. This canal would connect the Mae Klong River with the Tachine River.

The excellent quality soil beside the canal is very fertile and suitable for growing many kinds of fruits and vegetables. The area is famous for Malacca grape, Chinese grapefruit,

mangoes, bananas, and coconut.

The Damnoen Saduak Floating Market is a very attractive place for tourists to see the old style and traditional way of selling and buying fruits, vegetables, etc., from small boats. Tourists will also see traditional Thai houses, the way they live and travel by boats, and please try riding on a small boat to experience the floating market and to see more. This is a worthwhile trip.

But, the poor little cub was miraculously survived from the injection of preservative formalin. Though frail and terrified, the animal was cured and recovered. Since then more orphaned and injured tigers have been sent to the temple.
