Visit and explore four revered temples in Chiang Mai. All constructed during the Lanna period, each reflects the glory, splendors and nobility of a rich historical era.

Wat Suan Dok: Built by King Kuna, the large white chedi towers above the numerous small ones and contains the ashes of the Lanna King and the remains of many generations of the old Chiang Mai Royal family.

Wat Phra Singh: -. First built during the reign of Phra Chao Kham Fu (1328-1335) the temple compound includes the Lai Kam Chapel and the abbot of this important temple is the head of the local religious administration.

Wat Chedi Luang: - Lying smack in the heart of the city (almost right in the middle of the square-walled city) The large Chedi (the biggest in the city) behind the viharn was constructed by King Saen Muang Ma around 1401. Originally 90 meters high, it is now a mere 40 meters as the result of an earthquake in 1545. A small building near the main entrance encloses the "Sao Intakin" (spirit of the city).

Wat Chiang Mun: - Lying in the Northern part of the old walled city, it is the oldest temple within the city walls. Constructed by King Mengrai (1296-1311) the founder of Chiangmai, it is said that the king spent his last years at this temple

Drive around the old city to see the moat surrounding it and the ruins of the city gates.

Then visit **Worarot Market**, the largest central market, alive with its daily hustle and bustle. Exotic fresh fruits, preserved food, local delicacies, clothes galore, flowers and etc.

Wat Prathat Doi Suthep is the most important and famous in Chiang Mai landmark. The tour begins with a pleasant winding drive up 3,500 feet above sea level to the sacred temple of Doi Suthep. You then ascend up the 300 steps to the temple gateway which guarded by two splendid Nagas (naks). Walk around the grounds of Doi Suthep past golden pillars, six foot gongs and rows of bells. A three tiered umbrella made of gold sat on display in the inner courtyard. Wat Prathat Doi Suthep was built in 1383, is the symbol of Chiang Mai. It is the most sacred temple in the city and contains the holy relic of the Lord Buddha which is enshrined in the magnificent golden pagoda that can be seen for miles around. A panoramic view of the city and the surrounding countryside can be seen from the temple grounds.

The trip entails a pleasant 15 km. winding drive up 3,500 feet above sea level to visit **Wat Prathat Doi Suthep Temple**, the most sacred temple in the city. You then exercise your heart, lungs and limbs (perfect for couch potatoes and those with beer belly) by ascending the steps to the temple, guarded by two magnificent nagas (naks). Constructed in 1383, this symbol of Chiang Mai contains the holy relic of the Lord Buddha which is enshrined in the magnificent, glowing golden pagoda. A bird's eye view of the entire city and the surrounding areas can be seen from the temple grounds.

Continue by local truck along a bumpy mountain road to visit the **White Meo hilltribe village** - It's a scenic route. Migrants from China, they prefer to live in simple, isolated and self-sustaining villages while preserving their primitive culture, ancient customs and gorgeous embroidered costumes.

Return back to town.

Pick up from hotel and Lying south of Chiang Mai, the granite mass of Doi Inthanon, at 8,500 feet above sea level, is the highest mountain in the country. **Doi Inthanon** is the tail of Himalaya mountain range. Designated as a national park, the moist natural environment is a paradise for birds as it has almost 400 species, animals, flowers and fauna.

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After a final steep climb, the summit is surprisingly flat though misty, cool and breezy. Visit the pagodas built in honor of their Majesties the King and Queen. The magnificent chedi completed in 1989 to honor the 60th birthday of King Bhumipol. A visitors' center contains information in Thai and English. A small chedi above the visitors' center contains the remains of Chao Inthawichayanon the last independent ruler of Chiangmai, who died in 1897, after which the Kingdom of Lanna was incorporated into Siam.

After lunch enjoy the cool cascading waters of Mae Klang or Vachiratharn waterfalls. Visit a Karen hill tribe village at Baan Sop Had. Transfer back to hotel.

Pick up from Hotel and start the trip by road along Doi Saket - Chaing Rai route, driving through undulating hills and valleys, emerald green woods, quaint small towns and picturesque villages.

A break is made at Mae Kachan hot spring then proceed on to the town (and province) of Chiang Rai.

Visit and explore the Yao and Akha hill tribe villages and see their quaint, unique costumes. Each tribe has its own culture, customs, traditions and dialect after that visit the ancient town of Chiang Saen, the very first kingdom in Thailand. Chiang Saen was the capital for the kingdom until 13th C. when King Mengri the founder of Lanna Kingdom moved the capital to Chiang Rai. From 16th C to 18th c. Burma controlled here and the town was totally destroyed when Thai re-gain North Thailand. The city situated on the banks of the Mae Khong River and explores its archeological remains.

Lunch at local restaurant After lunch, proceed to the world-renowned Golden Triangle where the borders of Thailand, Laos and Myanmar meet at the confluence of the mighty Ma e Khong River. A superb view of the river and surrounding three countries can be seen.

Then drive further on to Mae Sai, a bustling border town with Myanmar and the northern most point of Thailand. Shop around for some Myanmar goodies then transfer back to Chiangmai

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KHAN TOKE DINNER

Relax in an informal atmosphere whilst dining on delicious northern Thai cuisine called "Khan Toke". "Khan" actually means bowl and "Toke" refers to a small, low, round floor table usually made of rattan or lacquer ware. The menu usually consists of "Gaeng Hang Lay" (pork curry with garlic, ginger and other spices), "Nam Prik Ong" (minced pork cooked with tomatoes, cucumbers, onions and chilies), "Cab Moo" (fried pork skin), and special deep fried chicken among the many choices. These dishes are eaten with "Kao Niew" (sticky rice), a special rice variety.

Tuck in and eat to your heart's content. During the meal, a traditional northern musical ensemble will play soothing music while charming dancers will entertain you with the fingernail dance, candle dance, sword dance and ramwong dance. If you get the urge, join in the ramwong dance...it's great. After that, there will be a fireworks display. Then, a selection of hill tribe dances performed by the Akha, Yao, Lisu and Karen tribes rounds up this entertaining evening. (Loose, informal attire is recommended as you will be sitting down on the floor).

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
